ALTOONA, PA, December 14, 2009—Images by railroad artist Robert L. Hunt will be on display at Alto Model Train Museum Association (AMTMA)'s exhibits at Lakemont Park through January 3, 2010. The images on canvas are available for purchase with a portion of proceeds benefiting the organization.

A self-taught artist, Robert L. Hunt enjoys national recognition for his railroad and historical paintings. The prints on canvas available at the AMTMA exhibit are limited edition, framed and ready to hang.

In addition to the displays at Lakemont Park which are open nightly from 6 p.m. until 10 p.m., the AMTMA will host an open house at its 2817 Industrial Avenue, Rockway Building, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor location December 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Activities for children including Thomas, Brio play tables, a Cinderella castle and two riding Thomas trains will be offered in addition to the operating Lionel, American Flyer and other layouts.
